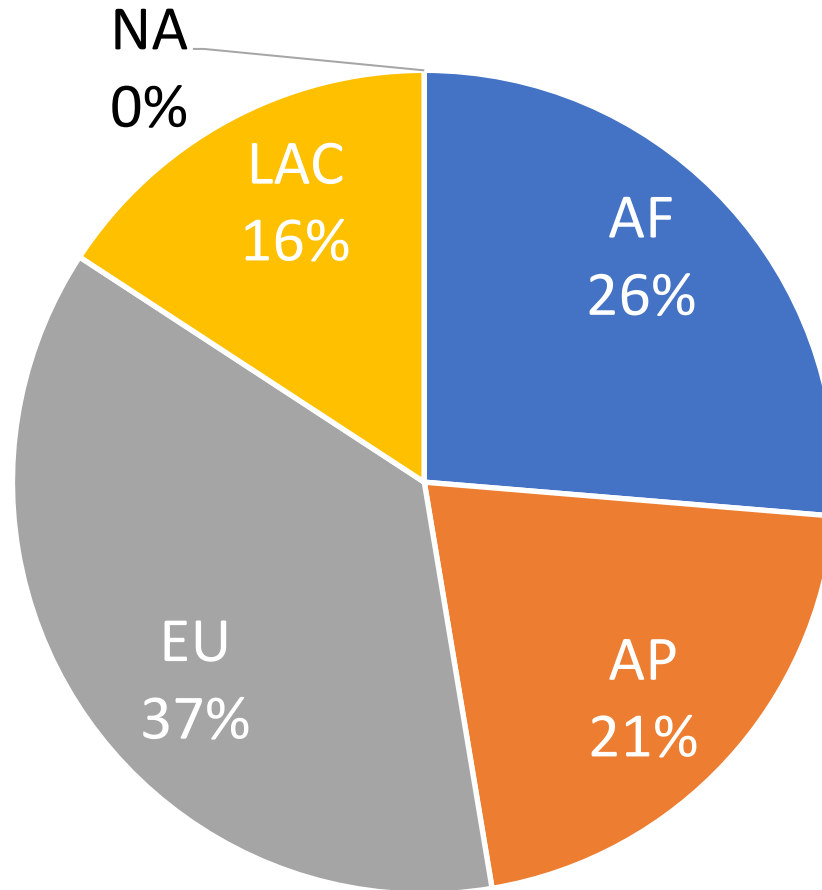

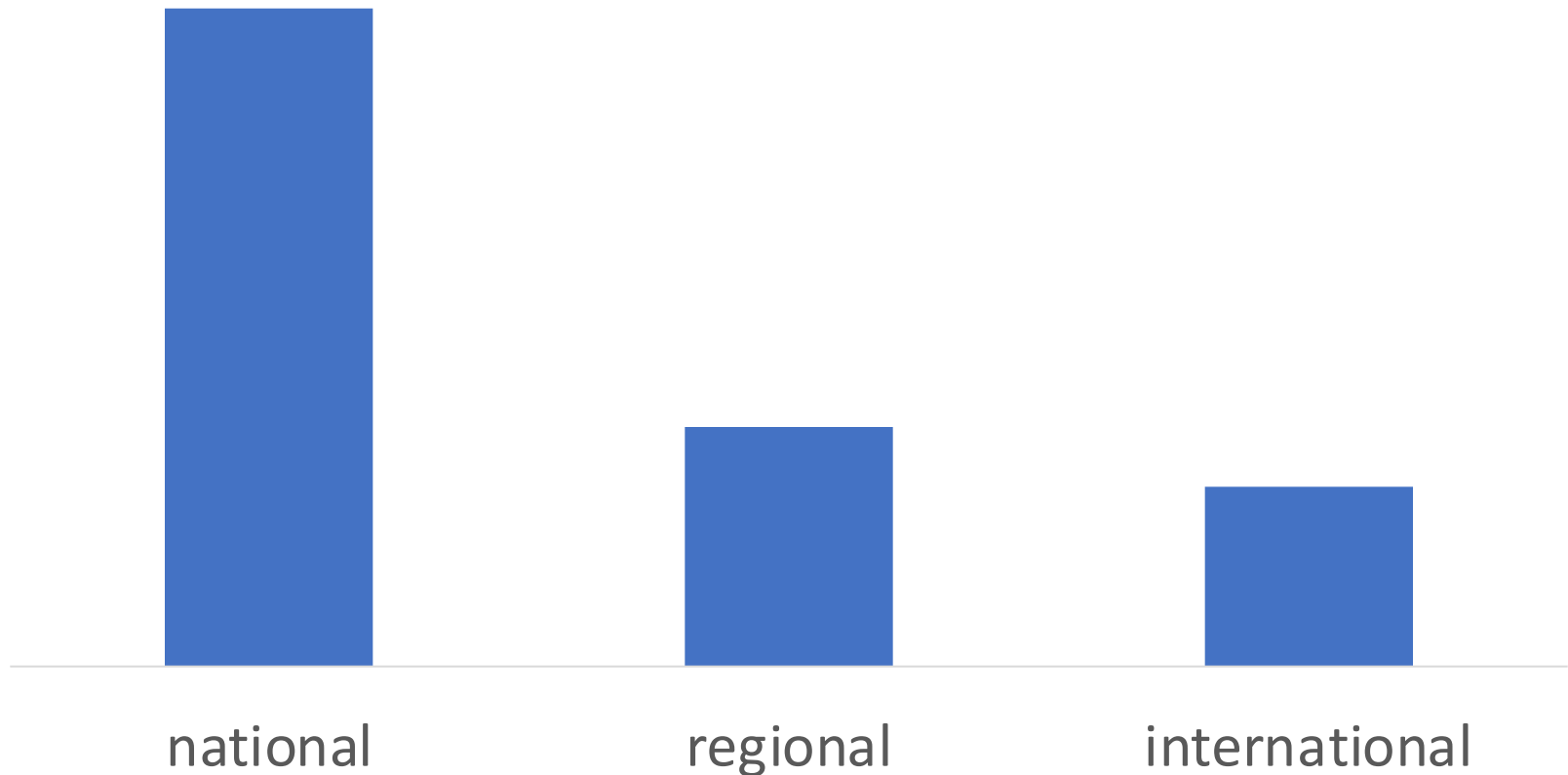

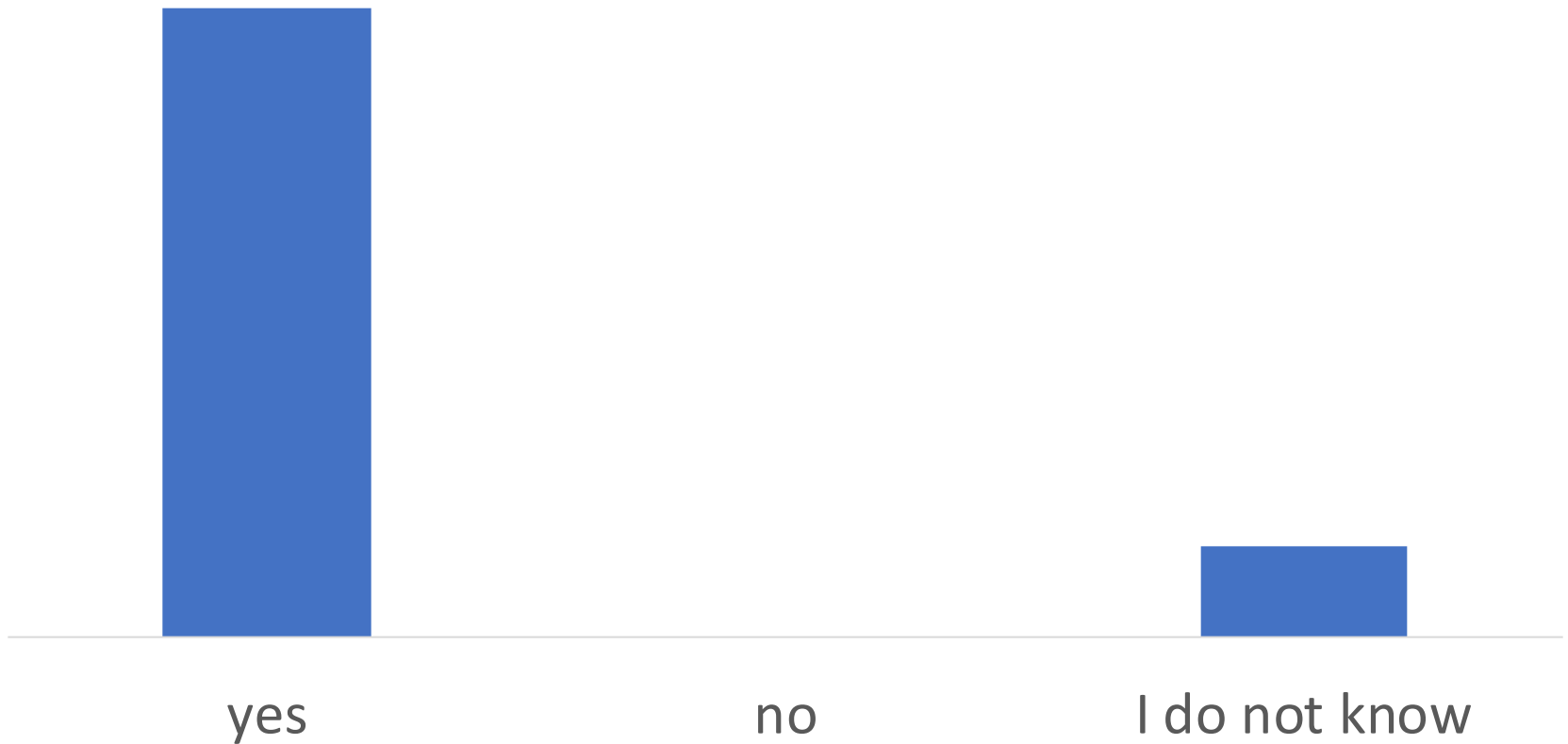
Events per region



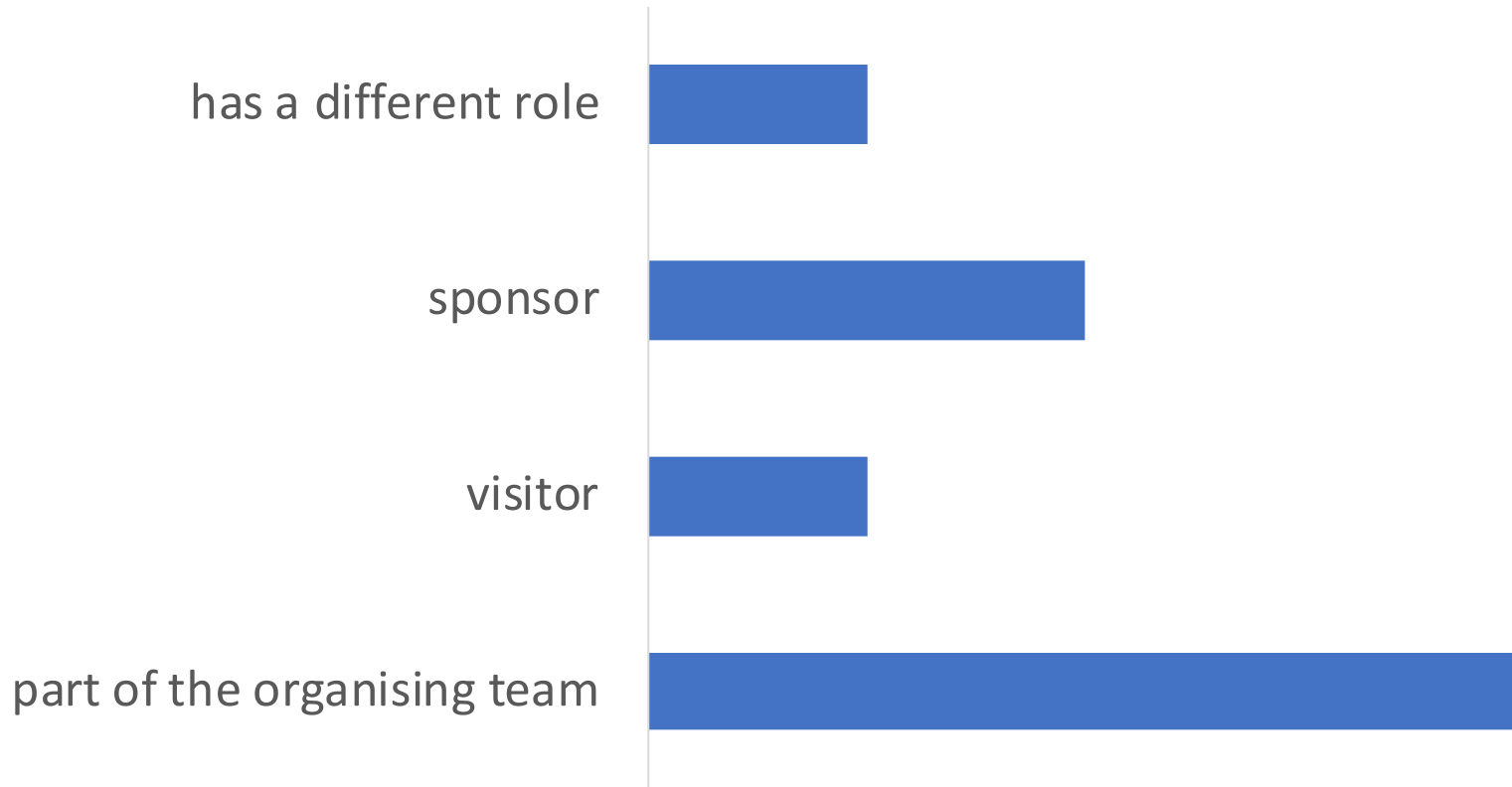
Type of event, programme, initiative



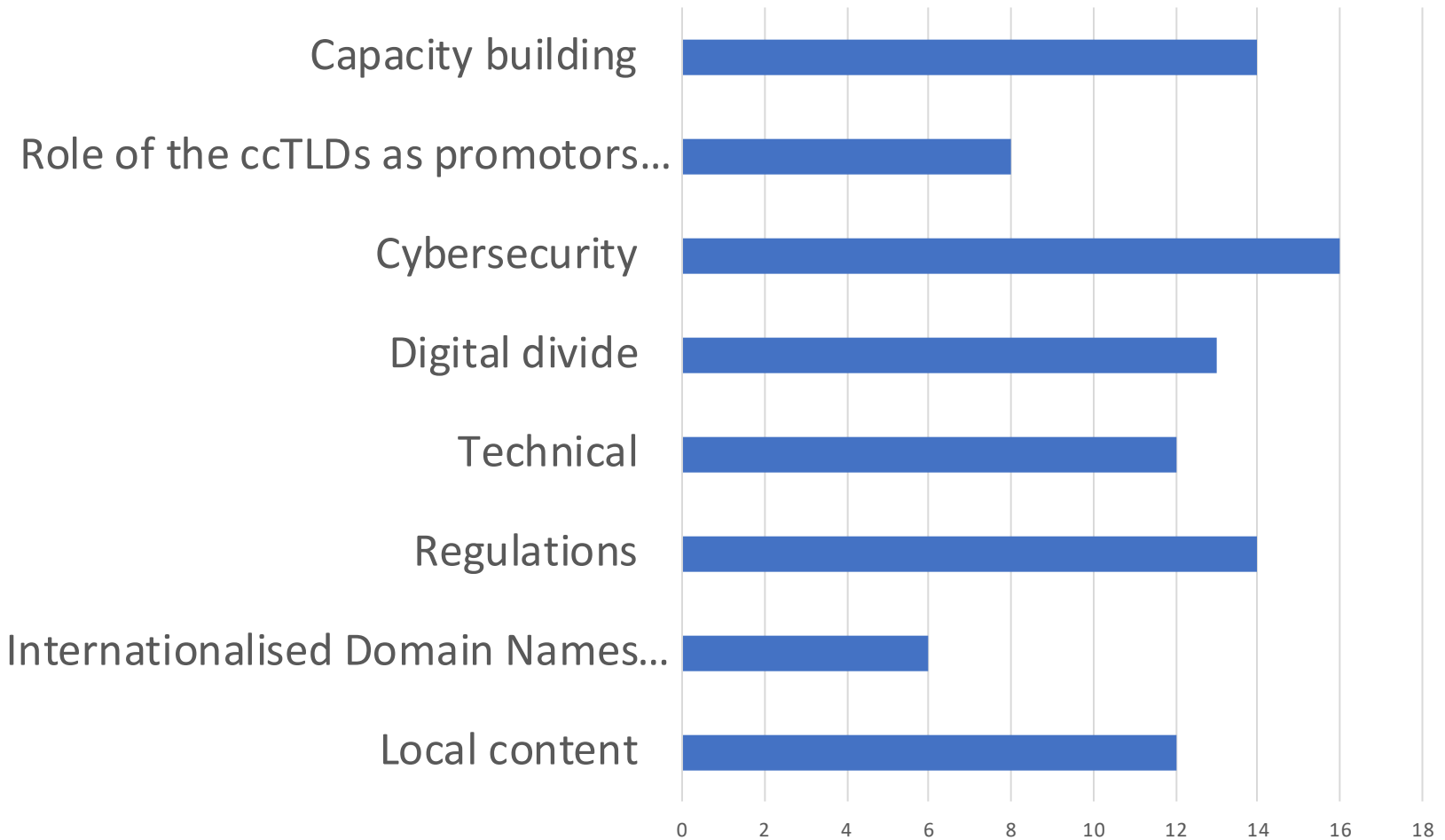
Are ccTLDs attending or participating?
